WHEREAS

1. CENTRAL HINDU MILITARY EDUCATION SOCIETY, NASHIK is a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 so also is an educational charitable trust, under the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950 pursuing its objects of imparting formal and informal education in various disciplines.
2. The party of the first part is in process of establishing a college of Nursing in Nashik City in the name *Bhonsala Institute of Nursing* with appropriate permissions from Indian Nursing Council, Maharashtra Nursing Council, Govt. of Maharashtra and affiliated to MAHARASHTRA UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES, NASHIK. ^{Director} Herein after referred as *College/ Institution*
3. Party of the Second Part, is a company incorporated and registered under the Companies Act. 1956, and having its main objects of establishing and running hospitals and health care facilities. SHL is presently running I managing various hospitals, pathology labs and diagnostics centre" in Pune as well as the rest of Maharashtra, SHL is managing Sahyadri Speciality Hospital of ~~Kankar Mitra Mandal~~ Medical Trust located at Wadala Road, Near Dwarka Circle Nashik. (Hereinafter referred to as the said "HOSPITAL" for the sake of brevity.)

NOW THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITNESSETH AS UNDER:

1. SCOPE:

The scope of this understanding extends only to deputation of the students by Party of the First Part up to intake capacity for all classes, for imparting of practical training and examination as contemplated by the concerned syllabus for the discipline/s, in batches each comprising of about 30-40 students led by its faculty members to the said Hospital, and other incidental and ancillary matters related thereto.



2. DURATION:

2.1 The duration of this understanding shall be for a period of FIVE Academic years starting from date of execution of this MOU or from the date of the forth coming academic year unless expressly extended.

2.2 Both the parties can cancel or terminate the present MOU by giving three Months prior notice in writing to each other. In case of dispute, the same will be referred to the sole Arbitrator appointed under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, by the parties with mutual understanding, whose decision shall be final and binding on both the parties. *Arbitration proceedings shall take place at Bangalore.*

2.3 CLINICAL ROTATION PLAN:

The rotation of the student will be planned according to the curriculum described by the College / institution only. The students shall receive training in all the specialities in the Hospital.

2.4 The Rotation of the students will be planned by Principal, of the Bhonsala Nursing college or institution, and will be submitted to the Nursing service department of the Hospital prior to the posting at the beginning of the Academic Year.

2.5 DUTY HOURS:

First year B.Sc./P.B.B.Sc Nursing students will be posted from 8:30 am to 12:30 pm and rest of the students will be posted for full day as per the curriculum prescribed by Indian Nursing Council and Principal, of the Bhonsala Nursing college or institution in co ordination with the SHL, except during holidays of the SHL and the holidays mentioned in the academic year, vacations, examination and for any other institutional activities.

3. INSPECTION:

3. INSPECTION:

The authorities appointed by the statutory bodies and DMR for the purpose of inspecting the clinical specialties for the B.Sc. Nursing Programmes as under:

- a) Indian Nursing Council,
- b) Maharashtra Nursing Council,
- c) State Government and

These authorities shall inspect the clinical facilities in the first, second, third and fourth year of the programme of B.Sc./ P B B.Sc Nursing and then from time to time for recognition of the B.Sc./P B B.Sc Nursing programme. Principal, of the *Bhonsala Institute of Nursing* or institution shall give prior intimation to the said hospital before start of inspection.

4. DEMOGRAPHIC DATA OF THE HOSPITAL:

The demographic data of the hospital may be required to be furnished to the Vidyapeeth application to the Governing Council; Principal, of the *Bhonsala Institute of Nursing* or institution agrees that prior intimation in this regard shall be given to the Hospital and the demographic data shall be availed from the Hospital authorities. *The College/Institution agrees to maintain the confidentiality of the demographic data as given by the hospital.*

5. ASSISTANCE FROM HOSPITAL:

5.1 The Hospital Nursing, Medical and Paramedical personnel shall assist the students of the *Bhonsala Nursing College*, in clinical teaching as and when found necessary and shall guide the students and staff in hospital policies and routine.

5.2 The hospital should allow the use of hospital equipment and supplies for nursing care of the patients and demonstration of nursing procedures, as deemed suitable.



6. AGREEMENT:

6.1 SHL hereby agrees and permits the College to depute students up to its intake capacity in batches, each comprising of about 30 students led by its faculty members to the said Hospital for imparting of Practical training and examination of students as contemplated by the concerned syllabus.

6.2 The said College shall acquaint the students with the norms of discipline to be followed while on the premises of the said Hospital with appropriate notice that in case of any indiscipline by any of the students, the Hospital shall have right to restrict her / him from entering the premises of the said Hospital after informing the same to *TMV College/Institution*.

6.3 The students will not be permitted to attend to patients unless they are supervised and accompanied by their authorized tutors. The names of the tutors will be provided by the Principal at the beginning of the Academic Year.

6.4 The said College is permitted to hold its practical and / or theoretical training in consonance with the syllabus prescribed for the course and to hold examination in the said Hospital, without however disturbing the working of the said Hospital.

6.5 The parties shall maintain a register of students attending at the said Hospital for recording of attendance of the students in the premises of the said Hospital and the said register shall be verified by the faculty member leading the batches on the other hand and/or any authorized staff of the said Hospital.

The said register shall remain in custody of said college and on each deputation shall be brought to the said Hospital for verification by the parties in terms hereof.



7. CONSIDERATION:

7.1 In consideration of this MOU, the institute shall pay (and / or caused to be paid through the said College) an amount @ of Rs.500-(Rs. Five hundred only) per student per month as workshop fees during the period of their training in the said Hospital with yearly increase of 10%. The institute shall pay the fees in advance, 7 days prior to posts.

7.2 It is agreed by and between the parties that the party of the first part shall make the payment to the party of the second part by an account payee cheque to be drawn in the name of "SHL - Academics".

8. OBLIGATIONS:

8.1 The Institute of Nursing Education and research, the said College and the faculty leading the batches shall be responsible for maintenance of discipline, directives, decorum and good behavior of and by the students on the premises of the said Hospital.

8.2 Since the matter relates to the academic year of the concerned students of the said College, except in cases of gross indiscipline and misdemeanor, the said hospital shall not restrain the students deputed in the terms hereof.

8.3 In the very nature of the matter, the parties here to undertake to provide all necessary co-operation to each other, so that the education of the students of the said College is not hampered.

8.4 The Principal and staff of Nursing college will encourage their students to seek employment in SHL Group of hospitals on completion of their course and obtaining a degree.

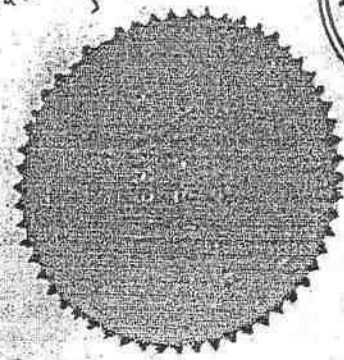

The following general conditions shall apply as per the type of the industry

- 1) You shall provide facility for collection of environmental samples and samples of trade and sewage effluents, air emissions and hazardous waste to the Board staff at the terminal or designated points and shall pay to the Board for the services rendered in this behalf.
- 2) You should monitor effluent quality, stack emissions, noise and ambient air quality quarterly.
- 3) You shall provide ports in the chimney/(s) and facilities such as ladder, platform etc. for monitoring the air emissions and the same shall be open for inspection to/and for use of the Board's Staff. The chimney(s) vents attached to various sources of emission shall be designated by numbers such as S-1, S-2, etc. and these shall be painted/ displayed to facilitate identification.
- 4) Whenever due to any accident or other unforeseen act or even, such emissions occur or is apprehended to occur in excess of standards laid down, such information shall be forthwith Reported to Board, concerned Police Station, office of Directorate of Health Services, Department of Explosives, Inspectorate of Factories and Local Body. In case of failure of pollution control equipments, the production process connected to it shall be stopped.
- 5) You shall provide an alternate electric power source sufficient to operate all pollution control facilities installed to maintain compliance with the terms and conditions of the consent. In the absence, the applicant shall stop, reduce or otherwise, control production to abide by terms and conditions of this consent.
- 6) You shall submit, the Environmental Statement Report for the financial year ending 31st March in the prescribed Form-V as per the provisions of rule 14 of the Environment (Protection) (Second Amendment) Rules, 1992 to Regional Office, Nashik, the 30th day of September every year.
- 7) You shall recycle/reprocess/reuse/recover Hazardous Waste as per the provision contain in the HW Rules 2016, which can be recycled /processed /reused /recovered and only waste which has to be incinerated shall go to incineration and waste which can be used for land filling and cannot be recycled/reprocessed etc should go for that purpose, in order to reduce load on incineration and landfill site/environment.

This agreement made at Nashik in the year Two Thousand nineteen between the Director, Six Sigma Medicare & Research Ltd - Best Multispeciality Hospital & Accidental Hospital, Nashik exercising executive power of the Government of Maharashtra hereinafter referred to as 'The Director' (Which expression shall unless context does not admit include his successors of the One Part) the present, Faculties of CENTRAL HINDU MILITARY EDUCATION SOCIETY'S BHONSALA INSTITUTE OF NURSING, NASHIK 1) Mr. Balasaheb Laxman Ghule (I/C Principal) the present Members of the Managing Committee of BHONSALA INSTITUTE OF NURSING, RAMBOOMI DR. MOONJE MARG NASHIK-422 005 hereinafter referred to as Nursing Institute (Basic B.Sc Nursing course) the CENTRAL MILITARY HINDU EDUCATION SOCIETY is registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (No.781 of 1935-1936) and having its registered office at 1ST FLOOR, BHONSALA BHAVAN, RAMBHOOMI DR.MOONJE MARG NASHIK-422005 hereinafter referred to as "The Principal" (Which expression shall unless the contest does not so admit, include then the survivors or survivor of them, the heirs, executors and administrators of the last survivor members or member of the time being of the Managing Committee of the said Institute) of the other part.

WHEREAS the nursing Institute is running course 'Basic B.Sc. Nursing' and situated at , RAMBOOMI DR. MOONJE MARG NASHIK-422 005 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Institute") which has no facilities for training students belonging to the said Institute.

AND WHEREAS the Institute and Principal have requested the Government to permit them to use 100 beds in Director, Six Sigma Medicare & Research Ltd - Best Multispeciality Hospital & Accidental Hospital, Nashik, as well as other facilities available in the said Hospital for being utilized by the Students of the said Institute for training.

AND WHEREAS the Government has agreed to permit the Nursing Institute and the Principal to utilize the said beds in the said Director, Six Sigma Medicare & Research Ltd - Best Multispeciality Hospital & Accidental Hospital, Nashik, short particulars of which beds are given in the second schedule herein under written on certain terms & conditions agreed between parties hereto.

AND WHEREAS the Institute and Principal have agreed to construct within three years from the date of this agreement a fully equipped Hospital consisting of 50 beds with modern sophisticated investigational amenities and facilities at their own cost and adjoining the Institute.

AND WHEREAS the parties are desirous of recording the said terms & conditions.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:-

1) In consideration of the grant of license by the government to the Principal to use of the said hospital furniture and equipment and incidental services to be provided by the government to the Nursing-Institute, the Principal shall pay to the government as and by way of license fee calculated at the rate of Rs. ---/- per student/day used by the Institute the said amount of the license fee shall be paid by the Principal to concerned Director, Six Sigma Medicare & Research Ltd - Best Multispeciality Hospital & Accidental Hospital, Nashik, in advance on the 20th day of August to 1st September each and every year during the subsistence of this license.

2) In pursuant of the said agreement and in consideration of the Principal agree to pay to the government license fee at the rate aforesaid at the time and in the manner hereinbefore mentioned, the Government hereby grants to the Principal a license and permission to have access to and use the said beds only for the purpose of training students of the license Institute during the period commencing from the 1st day of April 2019 and ending on the 31st day of April 2030 for three academic years.

Provided that if government is satisfied that the Institute and Principal have duly performed and observed all the terms and conditions of this agreement and have achieved reasonable and / or significant progress towards the construction on and setting up of their own Hospital the Government may grant extension of this license for such a further period and at such license fee as the Government may determine, considering the new rules of Indian Nursing Council (Dated 16/02/2012)

3) This License shall extend to the employees, agents, students and such other persons as may be lawfully required by the Institute for training the students of the Institute.

4) The Director, Public Health on behalf of Government hereby agrees:

(a) That the Principal may use the existing furniture, dead stock and clinical facilities belonging to the Hospital for the purpose of training students of the Institute. If any additional furniture, dead stock and equipment is required by the Nursing Institute for training students of the Institute as per the appropriate councils of India and universities requirement then the same shall be provided, installed and maintained by the Principal at their own costs. Provided that entire medical equipment of the said Hospital shall, at the discretion of Director, Six Sigma Medicare & Research Ltd - Best Multispeciality Hospital & Accidental Hospital, Nashik, of the said Hospital, be available to all the patients of the said Hospital.

(b) That the Director, Six Sigma Medicare & Research Ltd - Best Multispeciality Hospital & Accidental Hospital, Nashik, of the said Hospital shall be responsible for the care of the patients in the said Hospital. Provided that the exact condition and responsibility of administration, teaching and care of patients shall be worked out and fixed by mutual consultation between the Director, Six Sigma Medicare & Research Ltd - Best Multispeciality Hospital & Accidental Hospital in Nashik, Provided also that the decision in this regard by Director, Six Sigma Medicare & Research Ltd - Best Multispeciality Hospital & Accidental Hospital, Nashik, on the parties hereto.

(5) The Principal undertakes and agree:-

(a) to use the saidbeds in the said Hospital for the purpose of teaching its students only and for no other purpose whatsoever.

(b) at their own cost and risk to store items of furniture, equipment and property of Principal in the said Hospital after taking prior permission in writing of the Director, Six Sigma Medicare & Research Ltd - Best Multispeciality Hospital & Accidental Hospital, Nashik, of the said Hospital.

(c) the Principal require any additional staff for purposes of the training programme of the Institute, the same shall be appointed and maintained by the Principal at their own cost. Provided further the provision for residential quarters of such additional staff shall be made by the Institute and Principal at their own cost.

(d) during, the period of this agreement, the staff and the student of the Institute who will be in the premises of the said Hospital, shall be subject to the disciplinary control of the Director, Six Sigma Medicare & Research Ltd - Best Multispeciality Hospital & Accidental Hospital, Nashik.

(e) that the government shall be entitled to evaluate periodically, the recurring expenditure involved as a result of utilization of facilities of the said Hospital by the Institute and if upon evaluation, government is required to incur additional expenditure on that account, then the Principal shall bear and pay to the government such a additional recurring expenditure.

(f) to pay for or make good at their own expense any damage caused or done by any of the students and staff of the Institute to the inmates of the said Hospital and / or its property or any part of the said Hospital or any part pertaining thereto to which the staff and students of the Institute have

access, except for wear and tear related to the proper use of the said Hospital by the Institute.

(g) to keep at all times the said Hospital premise and its precincts clean, neat and in good sanitary conditions.

(h) not to do or permit anything upon the premises of the said Hospital and its precincts which may be a nuisance, annoyance or disturbance to the patients and inmates of the said Hospital or to the owners, occupiers or residents of other premises in the vicinity.

(I) that government or any other person authorized by Government from time to time shall have the right to inspect the said Hospital (including the said beds therein which the Principal are permitted to use) on behalf of the Government and the Principal, office bearers, staff and the students of the Institute shall render to such person full assistance enable person inspect the said Hospital. If such person requires the Principal to comply with directions in this behalf, then the Principal shall without demur comply with them.

(J) to comply with all the directions or instructions issued by the government from time to time.

(6) The License hereby granted shall not confer on the Principal, staff and students of the Institute any rights other than those hereby expressly granted.

(7) If the Principal fail to pay the license fee on the date fixed for payment under these presents or if and whenever there shall be a breach of any of the terms and conditions hereof by the Principal or if the Government is satisfied that the Principal have not achieved reasonable or significant progress towards the construction and setting up of their own hospital, then the License hereby granted may be terminated by the Government by giving to the Principal three months prior notice in writing in that

behalf and in the event of such termination or the expiration the Principal shall not be entitled to any damages caused to them or of the building/s or additional floors or improvements built or carried out on the premises of the said Hospital by the Principal.

(8) Without prejudice to any other rights and remedies of the Government arrears of the said License fee shall be deemed to be arrears of land revenue and as such may be recovered by the government from the Principal a arrears of and revenue under the provisions of the Maharashtra Land Revenue code, in 1966, and any amendments thereof.

9) The Licensee (Principal) shall indemnify and keep the licensor indemnified against all cost, charge, losses and damages which the licensor may suffer or incur by virtue of any negligence on the part of licensee which shall effect the licensor (Govt.) and to reimburse the licensor (Govt.) all such costs, charges or expenses losses or damages as the case may be, immediately on demand by the licensor (Govt.). The decision of the licensor (Govt.) in this regard shall be final and binding on the licensee and the licensee shall not have any right to dispute the same.

10) The licensee (Principal) shall not be entitled to carry out any renovation and interior work in said premises, as per their requirement.

11) The licensee (Principal) shall use the said premises only for its lawful object business purpose. The licensee (Manager) shall not carry out any business in contravention of any law or statute for the time being in force.

12) The licensee (Principal) shall comply with all rules, regulation and bye laws applied by the said premises.

13) The Licensee (Principal) shall not allow private person/ third person in the premises.

14) The licensee (Principal) shall not be entitled to sub- rent the said premises the licensee (Manager) shall, however, be entitled to permit any of its subsidiaries or affiliates to use the premises.

15) The licensee (Principal) shall have a right to peacefully enjoy the said premises subject to compliance with rules and regulation applicable to the said premises.

16) The licensee (Principal) shall not bring and store any hazardous or inflammable articles in the said premises.

17) The licensee (Principal) shall not do anything in the said premises which is likely to be a nuisance or annoyance to the other occupants or which can cause any damage to the said premises or any part thereof.

18) The License can be terminated by either party by giving three months notice of its intension to terminate the license without any reason the license shall be terminated at the expiry of such notice period.

19) The License terms and condition as may be mutually agreed upon at expiry of the license period provided herein.

For the renewed period, the parties shall execute and register a fresh licenses deed.

20) The licensor (Govt.) shall have to carry out inspection of the said premises, during reasonable working hours either by itself or through its agents, wherever possible.

21) The licensee (Principal) Shall be bound and liable, to pay all amounts as required in terms of this license deed till it uses and occupies the said premises in quiet vacant, peaceful and unencumbered condition.

- 3) You shall provide ports in the chimney/(s) and facilities such as ladder, platform etc. for monitoring the air emissions and the same shall be open for inspection to/and for use of the Board's Staff. The chimney(s) vents attached to various sources of emission shall be designated by numbers such as S-1, S-2, etc. and these shall be painted/ displayed to facilitate identification.
- 4) Whenever due to any accident or other unforeseen act or even, such emissions occur or is apprehended to occur in excess of standards laid down, such information shall be forthwith Reported to Board, concerned Police Station, office of Directorate of Health Services, Department of Explosives, Inspectorate of Factories and Local Body. In case of failure of pollution control equipments, the production process connected to it shall be stopped.
- 5) You shall provide an alternate electric power source sufficient to operate all pollution control facilities installed to maintain compliance with the terms and conditions of the consent. In the absence, the applicant shall stop, reduce or otherwise, control production to abide by terms and conditions of this consent.
- 6) You shall submit the Environmental Statement Report for the financial year ending 31st March in the prescribed Form-V as per the provisions of rule 14 of the Environment (Protection) (Second Amendment) Rules, 1992 to Regional Office, Nashik, the 30th day of September every year.
- 7) You shall recycle/reprocess/reuse/recover Hazardous Waste as per the provision contain in the HW Rules 2016, which can be recycled /processed /reused /recovered and only waste which has to be incinerated shall go to incineration and waste which can be used for land filling and cannot be recycled/reprocessed etc should go for that purpose, in order to reduce load on incineration and landfill site/environment
- 8) You shall comply with the Hazardous Waste Rules, 2016 and submit the Annual Returns to RO, Nashik as per Rule Hazardous Waste Rules, 2016 for the preceding year April to March in Form-IV by 30th June of every year.
- 9) An inspection book shall be opened and made available to the Board's officers during their visit to the HCE.
- 10) You shall strictly comply with the Water (P&CP) Act, 1974, Air (P&CP) Act, 1981 and Environmental Protection Act, 1986 and industry specific standard under EP Rules 1986 which are available on MPCB website (www.mpcb.gov.in)
