Day I (23.06.2022)

Key note address:

Day II (24.06.2022) Friday

Scientific session – 08 Session on 'Criteria VI 'Governance leadership and management' by **Dr. Sunil Thitame**, School of public Health and Social Medicine, it was focused on the criterion VI key indicators, matrix and the methods to fill the relevant data's of the said criterion.

Scientific session – 09 Session on 'Criteria VII 'Institutional values and best practices' by **Dr. Vidyasagar M**, HOD Pedodontics and preventive dentistry, the session was focused on criterion VII key indicators, matrix and the methods to fill the relevant data's of the said criterion.

Scientific session – 10 Session on 'Role of IQAC in quality initiatives sustains assurance enhancement and culture' was discussed by **Dr. Sunil Thitame**, School of public Health and Social Medicine, wherein it was highlighted that the significance of establishment of IQAC in the institutes or university and its role in relation to the quality related activities.

Scientific session – 12 Session on 'Nursing excellence certification' was delivered by **Dr. Rahul Deshmukh**, Quality Manager, MGM Medical College and Hospital, Aurangabad, it was focused on the various standards and guidelines for the excellence certification of nursing services.
